Beware of E-ZPass Phishing Scam

The E-ZPass Interagency Group is reporting a large number of complaints about bogus payment requests for tolls and violations.

New Jersey drivers should know that legitimate toll violation notices are sent by mail, not email, from the E-ZPass Customer Service Center in Newark, NJ. The web address for paying a legitimate violation to agencies in the New Jersey E-ZPass Group is www.EZPassNJ.com.
